VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE MEMBER

The Featherweight Club Volunteer Committee has capacity for up to 9 members. It is the driving force behind the strategy and ideas developed and implemented by Featherweight Club to support the babies and families of Mercy Hospital for Women's Neonatal Services Unit.

Volunteer members with a range of different skills and experience are sought. All volunteers must be dedicated to making a positive difference to the experience for babies and their families whilst in hospital, during the transition from hospital to home and beyond.

Members of the Volunteer Committee are currently appointed as Featherweight Club community representatives on the Victorian Department of Health's Neonatal Services Advisory Committee, Mercy Hospital for Women Featherweight Club Liaison Committee and the Mercy Health Breastmilk Bank Steering Committee. Opportunities for further appointments to other committees may arise in the future.

Term: 2 year appointment

Time Commitment: 2 hour meeting held bi-monthly (currently on a Saturday morning) and other project work.
It is important that volunteer applicants are able to commit adequate time to the role. It is an expectation that members of the Volunteer Committee will attend at least 75% of meetings (including scheduled teleconferences) held during the year and that they make a significant contribution to the Committee, including participation in working Groups of interest.
